Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Brian Fitzgerald.

Review of current issues and projects: Brian reviewed several matters that the Planning Commission had addressed in 2014, some of which are ongoing. The intent was to acquaint Alan and Doug, as new commission members, with these issues. The commission took no action, but discussed the following issues:

- b. Multi-town "Building Resilience" project and Leahy Center Environmental Summit
- c. FEMA Community Rating System

- e. Dowsville Headwaters land acquisition & Vigilante Road gate
- f. Father Logue/CHSP Hospital Block acquisition
- g. Development of GMP substation on former State Farm
- h. Harwood UHS stormwater assessment
- i. Mad River Valley Active Transportation Plan
- j. Wireless telecommunication facility reviews

Other Business: Doug asked about the status of improvements at the Vt. 100/U.S. 2 intersection in Moretown. The traffic study completed in 2012 recommended a three-way stop and highway markings, but nothing has happened. Brian will check with the RPC transportation planner.
